ACTIVATION

By: Dir, RSI - Init:

20 August 1942, as the 486th Bombardment Squadron (Medium), at Columbia Army Air Base, Columbia, South Carolina.

ASSIGNMENTS

3 June 1943, attached to NATAF for operational control. (Sect. I, par. e, G.O. 104, Hq. NAAF, 7 June 1943).

June 1943, attached Tactical Bomber Force for operational control.

22 August 1943, assigned to XII Air Force from IX Air Force. (G.O. 73, Hq. IX AF, 16 August 1943).

22 August 1943, assigned to NATAF. (G.O. 164, Hq. NAAF, 21 August 1943).

1 September 1943, American units assigned to NATAF revert to control of XII Air Support Command. This does not affect the attachment to Tactical Bomber Force for operational control. (G.O. 166, Hq. NAAF, 26 August 1943).

November 1943, assigned to the 57th Bombardment Wing (Medium).

1 January 1944, relieved from assignment to the XII Air Support Command and assigned to XII Bomber Command. (G.O. 1, Hq. XII AF, 3 January 1944).
