

Mon	th of December, 1943. Prepared by Capt. Everett B. Thomas, 488th Bomb
DAY	EVENTS
	Year ago today we moved from Columbia to Walterboro, S.C. Mission toda to pinpoint on bomb line near S. Ambrogio. Christmas packages have be to arrive.
2	Mission to pinpoint same as yesterdays. Afternoon mission same target Turkey for supper.
3	Mission to Sibenik, Yugoslavia. No excitement. Mosquito nets and sime equipment called in; so, evidently that danger has passed. Buckley and Jones received their captaincies. Bari was bombed last night and as he as 17 ships sunk or damaged.
4	Stand-down from 1030. Weather. Fresh meat for dinner. Dull, cold, d. day.
5	Mission to Squilla, and target and three alternates ten-tenths cloud or age. Pombs brought back. Pictures taken of the various department greaters.
8	Stand-down. Weather. Mission to Pescara, alternate for Ancona. A/A heavy. One plane holed Mission to Aquilla marshalling yards. One ship holed. Seventy-two say of mail in. Mostly packages.
10	Nission to Terni. No excitement. Stand-down all day. No coal nor acetylene to make stove; so, we moved Ops and S-2 into new quarters. This was formerly the hen coop and while considerable effort has been made to clean it out with fire and antiset the smell is still not that of atter of reses.
11	Stand-down all day. Rained all night. New quarters leaked like a sie and most everything soaked during the night.
12	Stand-down all day. Mission called off. Weather open and shut. Clear the afternoon.
13	Stand-down all day. Routine.
15	Mission to Orte. SNAFU. Stand-down. Simulated mission. The three Rover boys on a spree again night. Stole and wrecked truck. S-2 jeep loaned to officers to go to ies and stolen from in front of the theatre in Foggia.
	Mission to Zara. Mission to Terni. Complete cloud coverage over target bombs broug back. DFC's awarded to men in the Group. 488th got thee.
	Stand-down all day.
20	Stand-down all day. Stand-down all day. Arranged to have Squadron Christmas cards colored local Italian girl at Red Cross.
21	Stand-down all day.
22	Stand down all day.
	Stand-down all day. Revamped Christmas card into a design for invitat to Officers party and dance to be sent to near-by nurses.

	24 Stand-down all day. Capt. Thomas and It. R.M. Johnston hand-colored the dance invitations. "Night-before" parties in various quarters. Enlisted Men had a formal open house for their new club in the old Operations room. Have a first class bar, tables and settees all of which have been thoroughly scrubbed and blow torched to give a pleasing grained effect. Walls are decorated with cartoons and murals by Cpl. Hanna and T/Sgt. Vargas. 25 Merry Christmas. Turkey dinner with all the fixings.
	26 Stand-down all day. Rain Mud Everybody has the G.I.'s, but who caresthe turkey was good and there was plenty of it.
	27 Stand-down all day. Slippery field. Officers! party tonight. Good time
	had by all—some as early as nine o'clock. About 2000 hours a convoy of the lst Fighter Group, ground echelon, landed at the field and were
	very much put out to find the place occupied. Started to make themselves at home in the E.M.s! club and tried to sject our men. Luckily Lt. Haynes had
Table 1	not gone to the dance and was able to prevent it. Boy how the wind blew.
	28 Tent of some of the cooks burned down about 0630. Che man asleep, but got out. Wind still howling. Engle of the 489th killed on raid. Every ship
	hit (we were on stand-down).
	29 Stand-down all day. Cold. Wind. Vaccination. 30 Mission to Falconara.
	31 Stand-down all day. Parties all night. Sgt. M. Fox badly burned when his
	tent blew down and burned. E.M. had big party including strip teasers. Michalowski, Lavin, Saylor, Jones and Crane (all Lts. except Capt. Jones)
	and Sgts. Griffin, Krigbaum and Wells left for home. Good-bye 1943. Ain't
	we had fun.
